I graduated from Olustvere School of Services and Rural Economics in 2016, specializing in the native textiles of Estonia. These studies culminated with an exhibit of shawls of my own design. Since 2010 I have been actively involved in knitting workshops, and own a small craft shop in my hometown of Märjamaa.
