



LAIMA SPRANGAUSKAITE

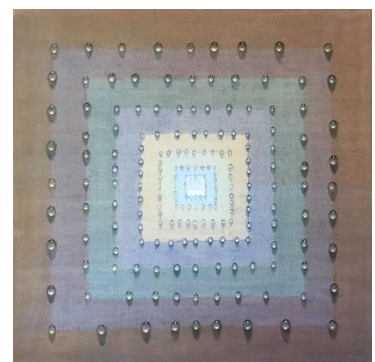
